

CEAS Detailed Activation Level Matrix


The matrix below is intended to provide further information regarding card usage during various CEAS activation levels declared by government.


When access to an area is “Permitted”, cardholders **MUST** have a work facility within the defined restricted area in order to use their CEAS card.

Please Note: Government has the authority to activate CEAS at any level they see fit based on situational need and has the right to restrict travel or access as necessary during an event. Regardless of activation status, law enforcement officials have the right to modify or deny access based on conditions existing at that moment.

*The examples below are not intended to be all-inclusive.

Activation Level Designation	Event Type	What it Means	CEAS Card Designation	Examples*
Level “X”	Non Specific	Emergency event is ongoing, all cardholder access is strictly prohibited	B	Crime Scene. or Conditions exist that are imminently hazardous to human life i.e. Hurricane making landfall

Level “A”	Travel Restrictions/Bans in place.	ANY CEAS Cardholder with a facility within the area of the restriction may travel. (“B” Cards or “C” Cards). Un-credentialed employees may travel (carpool) with credentialed employees.	B	Winter Storm effecting area. Travel ban in place

Level “B”	Event with defined boundaries.	ANY CEAS Cardholder with a facility within the restricted area is permitted access (“B” Cards or “C” Cards)	B	Localized emergency in which normal access to an area has been restricted
			C	
Level “C”	Event with defined boundaries	ONLY C-Level Cardholders with a facility in the restricted area are permitted access	B	Localized emergency in which access to an area has been restricted to Critical Infrastructure Only
