

USAGE TIPS FOR CARDHOLDERS

- CEAS must be activated before you can use your card.
- Cardholder **MUST** have a work facility within the “Restricted Area”.
- Cardholders should **NEVER** self-deploy unless pre-planned to do so or instructed to by company authority.
- **ALL** Cardholders, especially those using FLEX (non-photo) cards, should always carry a second form of government issued identification as well as a form of company ID.
- Cardholders should present their CEAS card to law enforcement authority when being stopped while traveling or trying to enter a restricted area. Cardholders should state their purpose and destination as an essential employee for the company.
- Misuse of a CEAS card can result in the card being confiscated by authorities. Make sure CEAS has been activated by government authority before attempting to travel or access a restricted area.
- Law enforcement personnel **ALWAYS** have the final authority to grant you permission to travel or access a restricted area. Cardholders are to obey public safety personnel regardless of the activation status of the program.
- Denial of access during a CEAS activation should be immediately reported to your Company Coordinator or appropriate company authority.
